REFLEXIVE VERBS - Les verbes pronominaux

Present tense

- *When a verb starts with a consonant :*

Se raser - To shave

Je me rase	I shave / I am shaving myself
Tu te rases	You shave / You are shaving yourself
Il se rase	He shaves / He is shaving himself
Elle se rase	She shaves / She is shaving herself
On se rase	We shave / We are shaving ourselves
Nous nous rasons	We shave / We are shaving ourselves
Vous vous rasez	You shave / You are shaving yourself
Ils se rasent	They shave / They are shaving themselves
Elles se rasent	They shave / They are shaving themselves

- *When a verb starts with a vowel :*

S'appeller - To be named / To be called

This verb usually translates to "My name is".

When a reflexive verb starts with a vowel, the reflexive pronoun before the verb will take an apostrophe, except NOUS and VOUS.

Je m'appelle	My name is
Tu t'appelles	Your name is
Il s'appelle	His name is
Elle s'appelle	Her name is
On s'appelle	Our name is
Nous nous appelons	Our name is
Vous vous appelez	Your name is
Ils s'appellent	Their name is
Elles s'appellent	Their name is
